- **Stakeholder management** In close collaboration with the Founder, support growth activities in the region including networking with potential clients and attendance at key sector conferences.
- Strategic development As a key member of a small team, contribute to the continuous improvement of Sustainability at School's approach through experience sharing and discussion with other members of the team.
